	Week One Theme: School/Friendship	Week Two Theme: Home & Family	Week Three Theme: Fun	Week Four Theme: Church
Day One	Write the names of all your friends at school and pray for God to look after them.	Sit and think about the street where you live. Pray for God's love in your street or road.	Sit on the floor and say thank you to God for all the toys and things you have to play with	Go around your house and pray for someone in every room. IDEAS family, friends, people who help us.
Day Two	Say thank you for all the things that are good about your school OR draw your school and say thank you to God for it	Find a dolly, teddy or toy and hold it in your arms. Pray for the safety of all the babies that are being born today in the world.	Lie flat and look up at the ceiling or sky. Notice things and look at your fingers and be amazed. Time to wonder and praise God	Read Romans 10v13 out loud. Change the word 'everyone' to 'children'.
Day Three	Read Proverbs 22v6. Pray that you can carry on learning whilst you have to stay at home	Cut out a large heart shape and write 'Jesus loves you' and ask your parents if you can stick it on a window for everyone to see.	Create your own treasure map. Think of all the things that you treasure or are special to you. Say Thank You to God for them	Sing or hum a song we sing at church that you like, even if you don't know all the words. Thank God for your voice.
Day Four	Make a paper doll chain. Put the names of your friends on each and draw on faces and clothes. Pray for each of your friends	Make a friendship bracelet and put it on your wrist. Every time you look at it today pray for your family	Read Isaiah 49 v 15 & 16. Pray that you will feel safe in God's love.	Thank God for our Church Family
Day Five	Sit for 2 minutes on a chair or the bottom of the stairs and pray for children who are struggling at home without school.	Lay on your bed and think of 3 countries you would like to pray for. Now thank God for them and pray for Christians in these countries that they will share Jesus with others e.g Italy, Philippines, China.	Find a joke book or make up your own. Tell your jokes to your family and when everyone laughs, thank God for laughter.	Think about the charities you know of or support. Pray for those that work for them e.g Tearfund, Guide Dogs for the Blind, Toybox
Day Six	Name all your friends at church and pray for them.	On your daily walk find a twig or branch. Give it a hug and thank God for nature and your church family	Imagine the best play park in the world and what you would do there. Thank God for your body	Pray for people who can't celebrate a birthday or be with their family today because of the virus
Day Seven	Draw a picture of a birthday cake with candles on it. Pray for all the children in our world who have a birthday today.	Look at a clock or watch and think about all the changes that have happened to you since school closed. Pray about anything that you are finding difficult	Find a box that no one wants and make something out of it e.g a house, castle or a mask. Thank God for your hands that can do so much with them.	Say Thank You for: Bubbles by wiggling your fingers Splash by waving your arms Xtreme Splash by wiggling your toes Xtreme by dancing around
