
PRAYER WALK TO EMMAUS



You will need:

Scissors
Card or Paper
Felt tips or colouring pencils

Bible Base: Luke 24 v13-32

This prayer walk is designed to do in the rooms of your home with your family who live with you.

FIRST:

- 1. Put your foot on a piece of paper and draw around it.
- 2. Cut it out and use it to cut out 10 pairs of feet. You may need more if you live in a big house
- 3. Now cut out 5 rock shapes using the shape below as a guide

NEXT:

- 1. On each rock copy the following things we can say or ask Jesus
- Rock 1 Thank you Jesus that you are with us always
- Rock 2 Jesus help us to pray for people who are sick
- Rock 3 Jesus help us to pray for people who are helping us
- **Rock 4 Thank you Jesus for your promises**
- Rock 5 Thank you Jesus that you love us no matter what

If you need help ask your parent to help you to cut out the shapes. Write the words and read the prayer rocks



NOW:

To create your prayer walk.

- 1. Ask you mum or dad when it will be best to do this
- 2. Lay out your prayer rocks on the floor either in one room or in 5 different rooms
- 3. Now put your foot prints to look like someone is walking from one rock to the next so you have a path to follow.

BE CAREFUL: Try not to stand on the foot prints or rocks in case you slip

If you did the family promise box I posted earlier this week you can put the box next to Rock 4 and use these promises when you get there.

PRAYER WALK

Start at Rock 1 and thank Jesus that he is always with you

Follow the foot prints to Rock 2
Pray about the people who are sick.

Follow the foot prints to Rock 3

Pray about all the people who are helping us IDEAS: doctors, nurses, people who are bringing food to our supermarkets, the Government,


bus and train drivers helping some people to get to work, police, the army and fire men who are keeping us safe

Follow the foot prints to Rock 4


Thank Jesus for his promises and say some of them out loud
