YOU WILL NEED:


A piece of thin card or thick paper

Glue Stick





Put the words below into the squares - one word in each square. Then decorate with felt pens around each word.

Sorry

Please

Helpme

Help

Once you have done this you can glue each tab and make it into cube.

PRAYER TIME

Roll the cube and if it lands on 'Thank You' say a Thank You prayer. If on 'Sorry' say a Sorry Prayer and so on. You won't know what sort of prayer you will pray until it stops rolling. Have Fun.
